

HOHENWALD CITY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that the Hohenwald City Election will be held on Thursday, May 7, 2015 for the following offices:

- City Mayor (4 year term)
- City Council (4 year term)

FIRST DAY TO PICK UP NOMINATING PETITIONS: November 21, 2014 Petitions may be picked up in the Election Commission Office located at 35 Smith Avenue, Hohenwald, during regular business hours through the qualifying deadline.

QUALIFYING DEADLINE: February 19, 2015 (12:00 / NOON) Nominating petitions for the City Mayor and City Council offices must be filed by this deadline.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: February 26, 2015 (12:00 / NOON) Withdrawal statements must be in writing and signed by the candidate.

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE: The last day to register in person to vote in this election is: TUESDAY, APRIL 7, 2015.

***** Voters who live outside the city and own property inside the city limits and who want to vote in city elections must register their city property with the Election Commission as a property rights qualification.**

NOTICE TO DISABLED OR ELDERLY VOTERS

Pursuant to T.C.A. §2-3-109, voters are advised that the Lewis County Election Commission Office, 35 Smith Avenue, Hohenwald, Tennessee, is a polling place that is accessible to physically disabled or elderly voters.

Physically disabled or elderly voters who believe that their polling place is inaccessible are encouraged to vote early or may vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day. Voters who desire to vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day must complete an affidavit at the Commission Office stating that their designated polling place is inaccessible. This affidavit must be received by the Election Commission no later than Monday, April 27, 2015.

Physically disabled or elderly voters have the right to vote by absentee ballot or during the early voting period pursuant to the provisions of T.C.A. §2-6-201. If information is needed for absentee or early voting procedures, please contact the Lewis County Election Commission Office at 931-796-0510 as soon as possible.

State law requires voters to present a photo ID issued by the federal or Tennessee state government when they present themselves to vote either at the Election Office or voting on Election Day at your assigned polling place.
